Swift River Softwood may be used in a range of applications including printing & writing papers, office papers, tissue and household grades. Swift River Softwood is bleached using an ECF sequence, is produced with fiber sourced from well-managed forests, and is available with FSC[®], SFI[®], or PEFC[™] Chain of Custody Certification.
